Tired of forgetting your ATM PIN?  
Wish you could change it yourself? Now you can!

You now have the ability to change your ATM/ Debit card  
PIN.

Step 1: Call 1.866.985.2273. If the number you are calling  
from or that you enter when prompted matches what is on  
record, you will go to step 2. If not, the call will be termi-  
nated.

Step 2: You'll be prompted to enter your last 4 SSN digits.  
When it matches, you'll be prompted to enter a new 4 digit  
PIN. If the SSN doesn't match, the call will end.

Step 3: For debit cards, you will be prompted to enter the  
CVV2 code and expiration date. If it matches, you will  
enter a new PIN. If it doesn't match, the call will end.

## WAKE UP

### *your dormant accounts*

It's nice to find some cash tucked into the pocket of your  
spring jacket or squirreled away in an old wallet.  
But don't forget about accounts you have at the credit  
union or other financial institutions. If you're not using the  
account, after a certain time period, you will be charged  
inactive fees.

Eventually, if you don't respond to attempts to find you and  
there are funds remaining, the money will be turned over to  
the state treasury, a process known as escheatment.

You can avoid losing track of your money by keeping your  
account active - depositing and withdrawing funds or set-  
ting up an automatic transfer or scheduled payment. Also,  
make sure your contact information is up-to-date.
